

FAQs

1. What about kosher observance?

All dinners will be pescatarian (fish), or vegetarian. Your home does not need to be kosher.

2. If I host, how many guests will I have?

You can host as many or as few guests as you like. The average will be 3-7 guests.

3. If I host, who will be my guests?

Hosts will have 4 choices for guests:

- Tier 1 Invite TE friends and/or TE acquaintances
- Tier 2 Invite TE friends and also host TE members who will be matched with you
- Tier 3 Host TE members who will be matched with you

Tier 4 - Host TE members with children under 18 who will be matched with you

4. If I am a guest, will I be required to bring food?

Hosts will provide dinner for their guests, but you can certainly offer to bring something.

5. What if I don't know many people at TE?

This is a great opportunity to meet new people, and to get to know people better. You can sign up as a guest and be matched with a host. You can sign up as a host, and we will match you with guests.

6. Is this for children too?

Families with children will be matched together.

7. When can I sign up?

Hosts and guests can begin signing up at any time! The deadline for signing up is Sunday, October 13, 2024.

8. Are all guests guaranteed a seat at someone's table?

This depends on how many TE members choose to host, as well as our ability to accommodate guests with food restrictions.
